Bible Point: Jesus remembers me! Thank you, Jesus!

Bible Verse: "God has been faithful in his love...and his saving power is seen everywhere on earth." Psalm 98:3

Materials Included:

- Seeds
- Small Clay Garden Pot
- Take Home Coloring Sheet

What to do:

- Fill the clay garden pot with soil, plant the seeds, water, and watch it grow!
- Complete the take home coloring sheet and discuss the Home Huddle Questions below.
- Read together the Spark Story Bible, The Empty Tomb on page 482.

Home Huddle Questions: These are designed for parents to follow-up, reinforce, and encourage the VBS concepts at home.

- **Home Huddle Questions:** Today we focused on Jesus' resurrection and his conversation with Mary Magdalene. After Jesus says her name, Mary recognizes him. Jesus remembers and cares for Mary, just as he does each one of us.
 - How does God remember? What are ways we can remember God? What can we do this summer to remember Jesus' love and share it?
- **Bible Buddy:** Ollie, the Otter, our Bible buddy for today, reminds us that Jesus remembers each one of us!
- **Practice the Bible Point**
 - One says:** Jesus remembers me!
 - All say:** Thank you, Jesus!
